



New Accounts: Commercial & Industrial

If you own or lease a commercial or industrial property you must assume responsibility for the water being delivered to the property. The following information will help prepare you to establish such service.

- The business owner or representative wishing to establish service must either call or come into the District office.
- A deposit will be required on all accounts. The deposit is refundable after meeting Newhall County Water District's criteria.
- An application for water service must be filled out, signed and returned to Newhall County Water District. Failure to return the signed application may result in termination of water service until the application has been received by an authorized Newhall County Water District's representative.
- A standard \$20.00 application fee is applied to your account on the service start date. An invoice will be mailed and is due upon receipt.

Deposits

Your deposit amount is calculated and based on 3 months worth of bills at the property within the last months. If there is no history, we will charge a deposit based on similar properties
