Memorandum of Understanding to form a Groundwater Sustainability Agency. At its regularly scheduled meeting on May 18, 2017, the Board of Directors of Newhall County Water District (the "District") will consider adopting a Memorandum of Understanding to form a Groundwater Sustainability Agency.

The District's Board of Directors will consider and determine if the District shall become a Groundwater Sustainability Agency (GSA) with Castaic Lake Water Agency, City of Santa Clarita, Los Angeles County Water Works District #36, County of Los Angeles, and Santa Clarita Water Division. This GSA will cover the Santa Clara River Valley East Subbasin of the Santa Clara River Valley Basin as defined in California Department of Water Resources Bulletin 118.
